Dear Occupant,

Island Roads, working in partnership with the Isle of Wight Council, are upgrading and maintaining the Islands highways network. In accordance with the contract requirements, the resurfacing programme is being carried out on all types of roads and across all areas to ensure the improvements are made at an equal pace across the Island.

We are writing to let you know about the carriageway resurfacing works due to take place in your local area shortly and to provide you with some information and guidance about what will happen during the works to enable you to plan accordingly.

Location of works:	Victoria Avenue, Shanklin – between Westhill Road and High Street	
Anticipated duration of works:	Start date: Tuesday 02/05/2017	Finish Date: Thursday 18/05/2017
Access to properties/businesses	For essential access please call our help desk on 01983 822440 to establish arrangements for which it will be necessary to allow additional journey times , as access may be subject to delay due to the position of large machinery and hot materials.	
Parking/Vehicle Removal	To enable us to complete our work successfully, please ensure all vehicles are moved from the carriageway . Please be aware alternative parking arrangements are the responsibility of each vehicle owner and not Island Roads. We will unfortunately have to remove any vehicles that remain on the carriageway within the road closure and relocate them to a safe alternative location nearby. In these circumstances, you can locate your vehicle by contacting our help desk on 01983 822440. Please note that Island Roads have the authority to remove vehicles in these circumstances from the carriageway and costs may be charged to the registered keeper if a vehicle has to be relocated.

We will be in St John's Road Car Park on Wednesday 26th April 2017 between 11am and 1pm to answer any questions that you may have about the scheme.

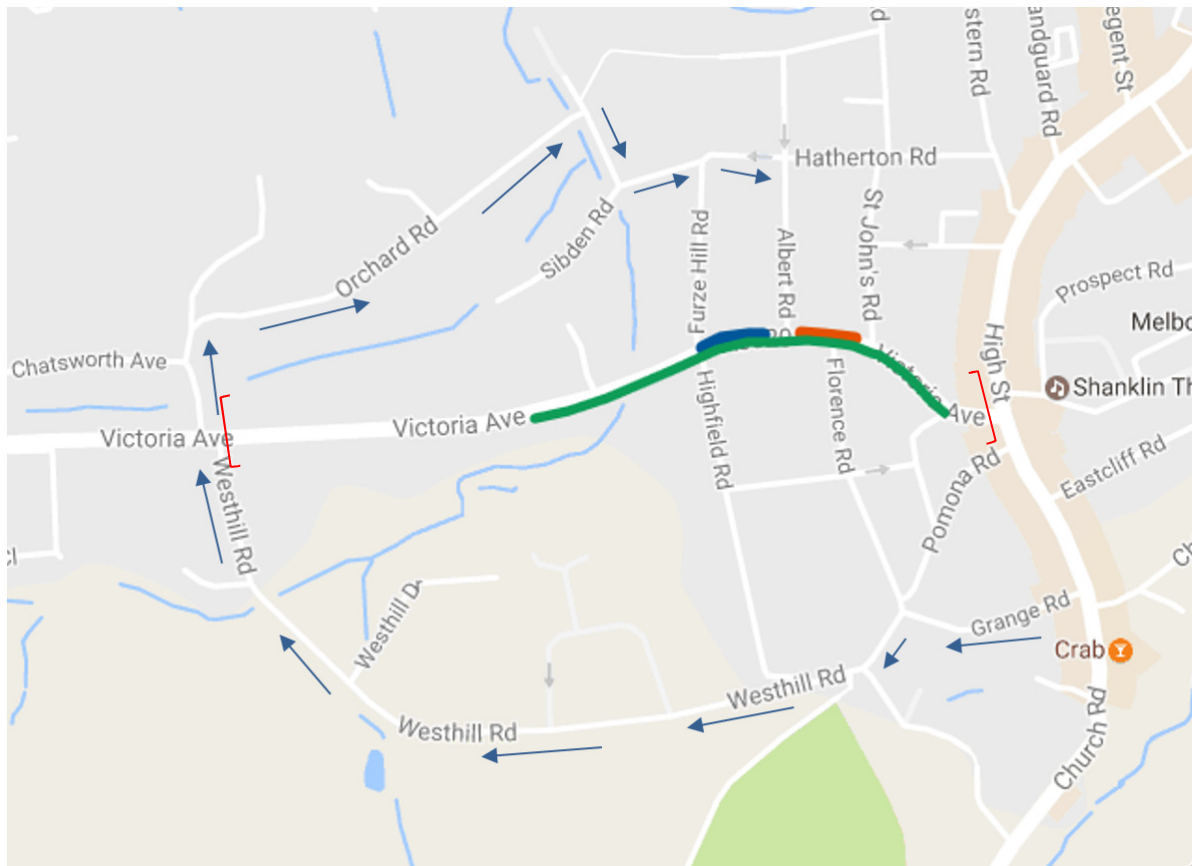

Victoria Avenue, Shanklin – Information



- At all times, Victoria Avenue will be closed between Westhill Road and High Street to through traffic.
- During phase 1 and 2, we will be undertaking full depth (350mm deep), full width carriageway reconstruction works. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses, apart from the sections that are being worked on, during the dates stated.
- During Phase 3, we will be undertaking full width carriageway resurfacing works only. There will be no access for vehicles unless pre-approved between 06:00 and 18:00 during the dates stated.

Phase 1	■	From Tue 02/05/2017 to Sun 07/05/2017 Traffic Management – Road Closure Day & Night
Phase 2	■	From Mon 08/05/2017 to Sun 14/05/2017 Traffic Management – Road Closure Day & Night
Phase 3	■	From Mon 15/05/2017 to Thu 18/05/2017 Traffic Management – Road Closure 06:00 to 18:00

Diversion Routes:

The diversion route for all through traffic and HGV's: Shanklin Road – Whitely Bank – Canteen Road – Ventnor Road – Newport Road, Apse Heath – Newport Road, Lake – Sandown Road, Lake - Sandown Road, Shanklin – Arthurs Hill – North Road – High Street.

Local traffic:

Although Island Roads will not direct traffic down the residential streets that run parallel with Victoria Avenue, it is without doubt that drivers will use their local knowledge and use them to avoid driving around the diversion route.

As these roads are public highway, we are unable to prevent them using these roads, therefore to reduce congestion and ensure road safety, we will be implementing a one-way system as follows and as depicted on the map above.

West to East Direction:

Chatsworth Avenue – Orchard Road – Batts Road – Sibden Road – Furze Hill Road - Hatherton Road

East to West Direction:

Grange Road - Pomona Road – Westhill Road

Southern Vectis

Southern Vectis will be diverting route No 2 via Apse Heath and Whitecross Lane. Further details are available on their website www.islandbuses.info/news or by calling them on 01983 827000.

Vehicular access will be maintained via St Johns Road. As Victoria Avenue will be closed to through traffic, parking will be permitted on-street between Salem Road and St Johns Road on the day.

Landguard Road (Co-op) – High Street – Grange Road – Pomona Road – Westhill Road – Victoria Avenue – Whitely Bank – Canteen Road – Ventnor Road – Newport Road - Whitecross Lane – Sandy Lane – Landguard Manor Road – Landguard Road (Co-op)
