### **Notification of Works**

#### **Reconstruction and Resurfacing of Fishbourne Lane, Fishbourne**

Island Roads are writing to inform you of our plans to undertake carriageway improvement works in Fishbourne Lane between Elenors Grove and the Wightlink terminal access. As you will be aware, this is a major gateway to the Island carrying a high volume of traffic and over time this has caused a significant deterioration in the road condition. We have worked carefully to consider how we can implement the changes required at the optimum time of the year whilst minimising the impact on those living and working in the area and on those visiting the Island and have worked closely with Wightlink and other local businesses as we have developed our plans. We hope that by sharing this information five months ahead of the initial phase of the works that this will enable you to plan accordingly.

The scope of work requires areas of Fishbourne Lane to be reconstructed to strengthen the road before resurfacing works can take place. Where possible, we will undertake the reconstruction works using temporary traffic signals, which will be in place 24/7 and manned during the daytime works. We will then require the road to be closed for both the remaining areas of reconstruction and all of the resurfacing works. Please find details of dates and times for the entire scheme.

We recognise that these improvement works may cause some short-term inconvenience for you, but we hope any disruption will be offset by the long-term improvements we are making to the road condition and the associated reduction in vibrations and noise from traffic that this will undoubtedly bring for local residents.

#### **Communication**

We have arranged for two drop-in sessions in the Victoria Room at Wightlink's Fishbourne Ferry Terminal if you would like to discuss the scheme and how this may affect you on:

- Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2019 between 11:30 and 13:30
- Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2019 between 13:30 and 15:30

We will also be writing to you again nearer the start of the works in July and again in August with any final details and information that you may need to requiring access to your property.

Traffic Management:	Temporary Traffic Signals / At All Times
Working Hours:	08:00 – 17:00
Type of Works:	Reconstruction

### Phase 3

Date:	Monday 30 <sup>th</sup> September 2019 – Friday 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2019 (5 weeks)
Traffic Management:	Road Closure 21:00 – 03:30 Monday to Thursday 22:00 – 03:30 Friday
Working Hours:	21:00 – 03:30 Monday to Thursday 22:00 – 03:30 Friday
Type of Works:	Reconstruction between property number 20 and Ashlake Copse Road (2 weeks) & Resurfacing between Elenors Grove and the Wightlink terminal (3 weeks)

Please note, there are a variety of factors including inclement weather and emergency works that may affect the timing of works. The timeframe provided in this letter are as accurate as possible at the time of writing.
