Update: Carriageway Works in Fishbourne Lane, Fishbourne

Dear Resident,

We are writing to update you on the upcoming reconstruction and resurfacing scheme in Fishbourne Lane, Fishbourne between Elenors Grove and the Wightlink terminal access.

The initial phase of this work is due to begin on Monday 15th July 2019 as previously communicated. This phase will continue for five working days with the works taking place between 08:00-17:00. This phase will be carried out under two-way traffic control along Fishbourne Lane, Fishbourne which will be in place at all times. The carriageway will remain open to both vehicle and pedestrian access, though delays are likely.

During works we aim to be as sensitive as possible to residents and keep noise to a minimum, however, typically these works do mean a certain level of noise is unavoidable.

Please take note of the following information with regards to the current phasing plan:

Phase 1

Traffic Management:	Temporary Traffic Signals / At All Times
Working Hours:	08:00 – 17:00
Type of Works:	Reconstruction

Phase 2

Date:	Monday 2 nd September 2019 – Friday 27 th September 2019 (4 weeks)
Traffic Management:	Temporary Traffic Signals / At All Times
Working Hours:	08:00 – 17:00
Type of Works:	Reconstruction

Phase 3

Date:	Monday 30 th September 2019 – Friday 1 st November 2019 (5 weeks)
Traffic Management:	Road Closure 21:00 – 03:30 Monday to Thursday 22:00 – 03:30 Friday
Working Hours:	21:00 – 03:30 Monday to Thursday 22:00 – 03:30 Friday
Type of Works:	Reconstruction between property number 20 and Ashlake Copse Road (2 weeks) & Resurfacing between Elenors Grove and the Wightlink terminal (3 weeks)

Please be aware that our programme can be affected by various external influences. Whilst we endeavour to keep to the allocated timeframe, please take note of the advanced signage in the area for date updates to the scheme.

In addition to the scheme works, during the next week, Island Roads will be carrying out a highway inspection throughout the scheme location for overhanging vegetation. Following this inspection Island Roads will issue any affected homeowners/occupants with a letter formally requesting that action is taken if the vegetation is deemed to encroach along the carriageway or footpaths to a dangerous or obstructive level. These levels are as follows:

- Carriageway (roads) – a height clearance of 5.50m and a clearance of 0.60m from the edge of the carriageway.
- Footways – a height clearance of 2.40m and with all vegetation cut back to the back edge of the footway.

We apologise for any short-term inconvenience these improvement works may cause, though we do hope that any disruption will be offset by the long-term improvements being made. Thank you in advance for your understanding and patience in this matter.
